

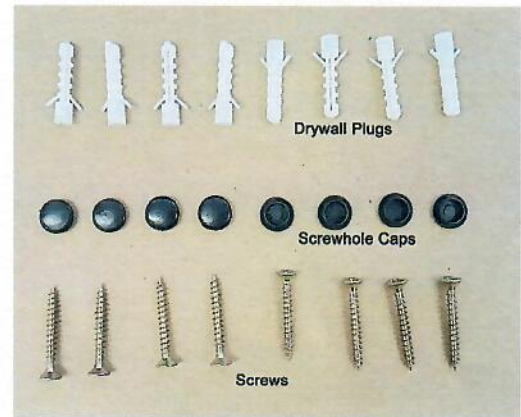
# Wall Rack Instructions

## Parts Included

- 1 Bottle End Holder – Strip A
- 1 Bottle Neck Holder – Strip B
- Screws
- Screw Hole Covers
- Drywall Plugs

## Tools Needed

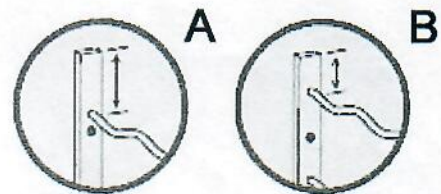
- Tape Measure
- Phillips Head Screw Driver
- Level
- Pencil
- Drill



## Instructions

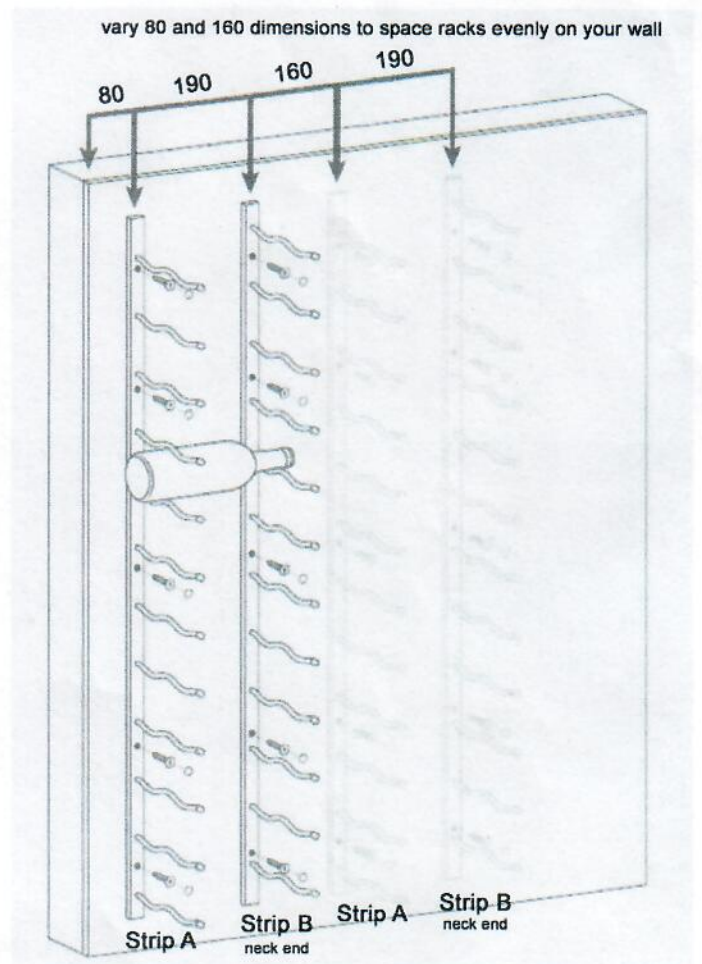
### 1. Choose Bottle Direction

The 2 Strips are different – locate according to the direction you want the bottles to face – in the diagram to the right the B strip is to the right of the A strip – so necks are to the right.



### 2. Mark Walls for Strip Locations

Work out the spacing of the strips according to the length of wall you want to rack – use drawing to the right to assist. Use a pencil and the level to mark the wall where the strips are to be located



### 3. Fastening

Locate the strip in position and mark the hole locations with a pencil. If gyprock wall – drill 8mm holes for drywall plugs. If timber wall (or studs are encountered) – screw directly into the timber. If masonry wall – drill 6.5mm hole for green wall plugs (not supplied)

### 4. Fix Strips to wall

Use Screws (provided) to screw the strips to the wall.

### 5. Insert Hole Covers

Push Screwhole Caps (provided) into holes to cover screws.
